FIRE SAFETY

When you arrive at the hotel Locate the nearest EXIT from your room. Please find out how to shut off room cooling, Get a good mental picture of your room and the corridors outside. Refer to the Fire Exit Plan behind the room's main door.

To avoid fire please

- Do not smoke in room
- Do not throw smoldering material in the waste basket
- Disconnect all electrical appliances after use

Our staff is experienced to handle fire incidents and frequent patrols are made to all parts of the premises.

If you discover or suspect a fire, dial 9 for operator

If it is a minor fire, remove any combustible items that are close to the fire. If it is a major fire, please leave the area after sounding an alarm. Switch off the cooling in your room. Lock the door and take the key with you. Leave the floor using the nearest fire EXIT.

Do not use the Elevator

If there is smoke in the corridor, avoid the elevator and head for the nearest Fire Exit. If EXIT seems unsafe, return to the room and shut the door quickly and stay there until help arrives.

If you are forced to stay in your room

Call the Operator (Dial 9) and give the location. Switch off the cooling in your room to prevent smoke being forced into room. Place the mattress up against the door. Use wet towels, sheet and other materials to stuff all door cracks in order to prevent smoke entering the room.

SERVICES AND FACILITIES

Air Conditioning

The hotel is centrally air-conditioned and each room has an independent temperature control device with which the temperature of the air conditioning can be controlled.

THINGS TO DO IN UDAIPUR

PLACES OF INTEREST

CITY PALACE City Palace (Raj Mahal), Udaipur is a palace complex situated in the city of Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It was built over a period of nearly 400 years, with contributions from several rulers of the Mewar dynasty. Its construction began in 1553, started by Maharana Udai Singh II of the Sisodia Rajput family as he shifted his capital from the erstwhile Chittor to the newfound city of Udaipur.^[1] The palace is located on the east bank of Lake Pichola and has several palaces built within its complex.

The City Palace in Udaipur was built in a flamboyant style and is considered the largest of its type in the state of Rajasthan. It was built atop a hill, in a fusion of the Rajasthani Rajput architecture providing a panoramic view of the city and its surroundings.

THE JAGDISH TEMPLE The Jagdish Temple, an exemplary piece of Indo-Aryan architecture, was built in 1651 by Maharana Jagat Singh I, the ruler of Udaipur. Dedicated to Lord Vishnu, known as Jagannath in this temple, it was originally named the Jagannath Rai Temple. The temple's construction took approximately 1.5 million rupees, a considerable sum at that time, highlighting the importance of this project to Maharana Jagat Singh I.

Standing in the heart of Udaipur, the temple is a part of the City Palace complex, making it easily accessible for locals and tourists. The temple's towering spire (Shikhar) is visible from afar, symbolising the omnipresence of the divine. The intricately carved pillars, adorned ceilings, and painted walls tell stories from the Hindu scriptures, offering a deep insight into the religious and cultural beliefs of the time.

SAHELIYON KI BARI

Built by Maharana Sangram Singh II as a garden for women, Saheliyon-ki-Bari or the Garden of the Maidens is a popular tourist destination. Along with a small museum, it has several attractions such as marble elephants, fountains, kiosks and a lotus pool.

LAKE PICHOLA

Picholi was the name of a village that lent its name to the lake. The islands of Jagniwas and Jagmandir are housed in this lake. Along the eastern banks of the lake lies the City Palace. A boat ride in the lake around sunset offers a breathtaking view of the Lake and City Palace.

FATEH SAGAR LAKE

This delightful lake, bordered by hills and woodlands, lies to the north of Lake Pichola. This artificial lake is connected to Lake Pichola by a canal. The lake houses the beautiful Nehru Island as well as an islet on which stands the Udaipur Solar Observatory. It was inaugurated by the Duke of Connaught and was initially called Connaught Bundh.

PRATAP MEMORIAL (MOTI MAGRI)

An impressive bronze statue of Maharana Pratap on his favourite horse Chetak, stands atop the Moti Magri overlooking Fateh Sagar. Local people climb up the hill to pay homage to Rana Pratap and his faithful charger 'Chetak' who was fiercely protective about its master and stood by him till its last breath. This loyal steed sacrificed its life while carrying his master to safety from the battlefield of Haldighati.

MONSOON PALACE

Situated just outside Udaipur, this 19th-century palace is built on top of Bansdara hills. Used as a monsoon palace and hunting lodge, its builder, Maharana Sajjan Singh, originally planned to make it an astronomical center. The plan was cancelled with Maharana Sajjan Singh's premature death. It is still an awe-inspiring sight on the Udaipur skyline and offers spectacular views of the city and the areas around.

AHAR MUSEUM

Ahar Museum is in close proximity to an impressive cluster of cenotaphs of the Maharanas of Mewar. The museum has a small, but rare collection of earthen pottery. You can also browse through sculptures and archaeological finds, a few dating back to 1700 BC. A 10th century metal figure of Buddha is a special attraction here.

GULAB BAGH -THE BIRD PARK

Bird Park at Gulab Bagh spreads over 5.11 hectare area. It has 12 enclosures. It has assorted Parrots house, Macaw and Cockatoo Courtyard, Lesser Passerine Section, Galliformes Runway, Flightless Birds Section, Aquatic Avifauna Section. It houses Green Munia, Great White Pelican, Sulphur-crested Cockatoo, Blue and Gold Macaw and a total of 28 species of Birds.

SUKHADIA CIRCLE

Sukhadia Circle lies to the north of Udaipur. It comprises a small pond that also houses a 21 foot tall, three-tiered marble fountain. Decorated with beautifully carved motifs, the fountain looks spectacular at night when it is lit up. The fountain is surrounded by gardens, creating a perfect oasis in a city bustling with tourists.

BHARATIYA LOK KALA MANDAL

Dedicated to the study of folk art, culture, songs and festivals of Rajasthan, Gujrat and Madhya Pradesh, Bharatiya Lok Kala Mandal is a cultural institution in Udaipur. Besides propagating folk culture, it also houses a museum that exhibits various artefacts of Rajasthani culture.

BAGORE KI HAVELI

Bagore-ki-Haveli is located by Lake Pichola, at Gangaur Ghat. Amar Chand Badwa, the Prime Minister of Mewar, built it in the 18th century. The massive palace has over a hundred rooms that display costumes and modern art. The glass and mirrors in the interiors are structured in classical haveli style.
